Now is the time to enroll for the 2019 - 2020 4-H year. Please note that the annual participation fee has gone up to \$25 from August 15th - October 31st, and \$30 starting November 1st for 4-H youth. Please do not create a new account if you already have an account. Just log in to your family profile and re-enroll for 2019 - 2020. Please wait until September 1st to enroll any incoming 3rd graders in your family, otherwise they will be considered a "non-competing" Clover Kid. If you are new to the system, you will need to create a family profile and add all youth and adults that will be participating. We recommend paying with a debit or credit card because the 4-H member will be in the system immediately. If you do not have a credit or debit card and need to pay with check or cash, please contact the office and payment arrangements will be made.
