

  to submit and pay for your entries.

4-H Enrollment for the 2021 - 2022 4-H year opens on August 16th for current 4-H members. If your child is going into 3rd grade this year wait until September 1st to enroll or they will be considered a Clover Kid, not a 4-H Member.

The cost is \$25 until November 1st then it increases to \$30.



### Short-cuts to enroll in Gray County 4-H

- 1. Open the Mozilla Firefox Browser
- 2. Go to v2.4honline.com
- 3. If you are a returning family PLEASE DO **NOT** CREATE A NEW PROFILE; rather, log in and update your information accordingly.
  - a. If you do not have your password, DO <u>NOT</u> CREATE A NEW PROFILE; rather, select "Reset Password?" and follow the prompts.
- 4. If you are a new family create your account by selecting "Don't have an account?" and follow the prompts.

#### IMPORTANT NOTES

- The Gray County Extension Office is here to help. Please call 669-8033 M-F 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. if you need assistance.
- There are notes along the right side of the window as you are updating and entering information. Please read them if you are having trouble.
- Enter an e-mail address that you check frequently. This e-mail address will be the one used to send you important 4-H News, updates, and deadline information.
- Enter or correct the 4-H members age and school grade.
- Club options are:

- Do not select Youth Council unless your child is on Youth Council. If your child is interested in being on Youth Council, please let us know and we will inform you how that works.

Majors livestock show participants must complete the quality counts enrollment when it is your first time showing at any Major Stock Show, or when you are advancing to the next age-group level in 4-H. (Elementary to Jr. High, and Jr. High to High School.)

### **QUALITY COUNTS ENROLLMENT**

**Before getting started:** For the best experience in the Quality Counts course, please use Mozilla Firefox as your internet source (Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, and Safari may work in some instances but are NOT suggested). Also, please make sure your browser (Firefox) has JavaScript and Cookies enabled. For desktop computers, you must have Adobe Flash Player 10.1 or greater installed.

We recommend using Firefox as your browser!

- 1. Go to: https://www.texaslivestockvalidation.com/qc/qcregister.aspx
- 2. Register with your information
  - a. It is very important to choose BOTH your 4-H and FFA chapter regardless of which you think you will show through!
  - b. You will need to enter your DOB and Phone Number in the format provided.
  - c. For grade level, please enter the grade you are entering (if between May-August) or your current grade, depending on the time of year you are registering in Quality Counts.
- 3. Click Submit Registration
- 4. This will trigger an email from dottie.goebel@ag.tamu.edu to keep for your records.
  - a. Do not delete this email as it contains a Return Link that you will NEED to come back to the course at any time.
- 5. Staying on the website, click Proceed to Curriculum.
- 6. You will be directed to the Quality Counts curriculum website.
- 7. The course is free, so click the blue Add to Cart button.
- 8. Click Create an account under the log in button if you do not have an account with AgriLife Learn.
  - a. Though you do have to create another login on a separate website, this is necessary to be able to leave and come back to the curriculum as many times as needed!
- 9. Click View Cart
- 10. Click Proceed to Checkout
- 11. Check the box next to "I agree with the Terms of Use," then click Next
- To access your course, scroll down to the section "Access Courses in D2L," then click on your course in blue
- 13. Click Quality Counts
- 14. Select Age Bracket according to your school grade as of August 31 of the current year.
- 15. Begin Course! The course will take approximately 2 hours to complete.
- 16. You may leave and come back to the course using the Return Link (Step 4a).
- 17. Once you complete the course, you will click Proceed to Test.
- 18. You must complete the exam once you start it, but you can take it as many times as needed to achieve an 80% or higher.
- 19. Once passed, your verified Quality Counts number is ready for livestock show entries!
